I have received your letter to me of June 7, 1989. The letter speaks volumes.

Senator Cranston, you may be astonished. I am not. My recounting of the meeting with you and your three senatorial colleagues in Senator DeConcini's office on I believe April 2, 1987, is fully accurate and fully truthful.

You, Senator Cranston, may not remainder what Senator -DeConcini proposed to me in that meeting. I don't know However, whether you remember or not, what I described did, in fact, occur.
