A We had been sharing notes about the meetings since the March 19th meeting. And at one point, I remember that we were discussing Senator Riegle's involvement, which was somewhat mysterious to both of us.

A Because we had the letter from Riegle. I think Laurie had a little more information -- I don't know that for sure -- she may have had more information than I did.
